

## **POLICY: INTERNATIONAL SERVICE POLICY**

The purpose of this policy is to promote service to the profession and help provide national and international leadership opportunities to Chapter members.

Although prior Board service is not a pre-requisite for all International volunteer opportunities, the Chapter will focus on those that have served and proven themselves at the chapter level when promoting the opportunities.

The Board will seek to keep senior level practitioners engaged with AFP by promoting AFP IHQ volunteer opportunities to them, be they at the Board, Committee or Task Force level.

The Board will also look to current Board members who participated, or expressed an interest in participating, in the Canadian Leadership Retreat.

The Board will aim to encourage to have 2 Chapter members involved per year on National or international Boards, Committees or Task Forces.
