- Support in developing tools for monitoring and evaluation to accompany the resource mobilization strategy
- Participate in pre-assignment online training
- Undertake public engagement and fundraising activities before, during, and after their volunteer assignment and will be equipped with tools, training, and support to achieve these goals
- Ensure the representation and engagement of women in all activities and program benefits
- Co-develop an e-volunteer work plan with the partner organization and country office using the WUSC e-volunteer work plan template
- Submit volunteer timesheets, reports and deliverables as required by the partner organization and WUSC.
