In 2015 the PCL/EllisDon Joint Venture joined pursued and ultimately executed the rehabilitation of the Centre Block of Parliament; the scale of the project necessitated this marriage of the two largest general contractors in Canada.

The construction team has grown from a small group to an interdisciplinary management team over 100 staff as well as a large team of subcontractors and suppliers; there are currently 300-400 workers and managers on-site at Centre Block every day.

Matthew Rinfret, Project Manager, leads the team who was contacted by the Royal Ottawa Foundation Board Chair Gordon Cudney to initiate a campaign in support of a temporary COVID-19 clinic at The Royal called C-Prompt.

The support of the individuals and companies involved in the project was immediate and generous; in 72 hours, the team had raised over \$200,000 in support of the C-Prompt clinic.

PCL/EllisDon Joint Venture is immensely proud and honoured to have taken part in such an important campaign, significantly since the entire industry responded immediately.
