



International Governance Participation & Development Policy

1. Introduction

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that wherever possible, provision are made in the Chapter's budget for Chapter leaders to participate in face to face meetings of AFP Global and AFP Canada. This helps enable the Chapter to fully participate in Association governance and develop and cultivate board members for potential leadership on the Chapter's Executive Committee.

2. Procedure

In adherence to Section XII of the Chapter Affiliation Agreement, the Chapter will send, subject only to budgetary constraints, the Chapter President and/or President-Elect to Chapter Presidents Council (CPC) meetings held twice per year in tandem with ICON (AFP Global's international conference), and to AFP LEAD. The Chapter will include provision in each annual budget to remove for the director any financial barriers to attend.

Further, the Chapter will provide funding where possible for at least one Chapter leader, in addition to the President or President-Elect, to attend AFP LEAD, with priority given to directors who have not previously attended.

The Chapter will also provide funding where possible for at least one Chapter leader, in addition to the President or President-Elect, to attend the Canadian Leadership Retreat each year, with priority given to Directors who have not previously attended.
